#### Engineering: Answers

1. After the second Pioneer was built, there was a new device used to measure depth, made from these two materials.
2. They pulled this behind the Hunley as the first type of torpedo deployment.
3. Ballast plays a major role in submarine design. The ballast tanks are used for this.
4. When the Hunley switched to the spar torpedo deployment system, the spar torpedo was located here on the ship.
5. Because of the lack of air in the submarine design, a candle could only burn for this amount of time when all the hatches were sealed.
6. There was a test done by the men of the Hunley to see how long they could stay under water without opening the hatches to refresh their oxygen supply. They stayed under for this long.
7. This was considered the top speed of the Hunley.
8. In order to get the Hunley to dive, ballasts were filled with water and submerged 3 inches below surface, to control depth after that, this was used.
9. The inclination of the ship was controlled by diving planes, this is the name of the device used to steer the Hunley.
10. In order to make the hatches rise out of the water, ballast tanks would need to be emptied of this.
11. To guide the ship, this instrument was used for directional control.
