H. L. Hunley Geography

- 1. New Orleans (LA)- where the predecessor to the Hunley was located. The Pioneer was built and tested on Mississippi River and Lake Ponchartrain.**
- 2. Mobile (AL)- city where engineers and backers moved to after capture of New Orleans. Pioneer II built here as well as Hunley. Pioneer II sinks in Mobile Bay.**
- 3. Atlanta (GA)- After request of Hunley by Beauregard in Charleston. Hunley makes trip to Charleston railroad where it most certainly went through Atlanta, which was the major connector of all railroads to all Southern States.**
- 4. Charleston (SC)- last stop of Hunley. Based in a cove behind Ft. Moultrie (Sullivan's Island) and then stationed on Mt. Pleasant.**
